A valid passport is required for international travel to Aruba.

How it works

- This year's program period runs from 7/01/2021 6/30/2022.
- · You earn I point for every \$1 spent (net sales tax) on your Carter Lumber account.
- Trip redemption occurs in August 2022.
- In order to redeem your points for a trip, your account must be current at both the time of redemption and at the time of the trip.

Point Rollover

Don't have enough points for a trip? Just choose the point rollover feature at redemption time, and we will carry the points towards next year's trip! Points may only be rolled over for one year only and do not apply to consecutive years.

New Travel Requirements in 2023

Beginning May 3, 2023, the Department of Homeland Security will require a REAL ID compliant driver's license/photo ID card marked with a **STAR** or the word "**ENHANCED**" or another form of federally acceptable identification (such as a valid US passport or Military ID) to board a domestic commercial flight or enter a federal building or military installation that requires ID to be presented upon entry.

If there is not a **STAR** or "**ENHANCED**" on your driver's license/photo ID card, or if it reads "**NOT FOR REAL ID PURPOSES**," it will not be considered a federally acceptable form of identification starting on May 3, 2023. Should you wish to upgrade your driver's license/photo ID card to a REAL ID, please visit the website www.dhs.gov/real-id-public-faqs for more information.

As a reminder, upgrading your driver's license or ID card to a REAL ID is optional but mandatory if you plan to use your ID for domestic flights. If you do not have a REAL ID compliant driver's license, you will require a valid US passport for a domestic flight. To apply for a US passport, please go to travel.state.gov.
