How it works

- In order to redeem your points for a trip, your account must be current at both the time of redemption and at the time of the trip.

Point Rollover

Don't have enough points for a trip? Just choose the point rollover feature at redemption time, and we will carry the points towards next year's trip! Points may only be rolled over for one year only and do not apply to consecutive years.

New Travel Requirements in 2021

Beginning May 3, 2023, the Department of Homeland Security will require a REAL ID-compliant driver's license/photo ID card, marked with a GOLD STAR, or another form of federally-acceptable identification (such as a valid US Passport or Military ID) to board a domestic commercial flight or enter a federal building or military installation that requires ID to be presented upon entry.

If there is NO GOLD STAR on your driver's license/photo ID card or it reads "NOT FOR REAL ID PURPOSES," it will not be considered a federally-acceptable form of identification on or after May 3, 2023. If you wish to upgrade your driver's license/photo ID card to a REAL ID, please visit the website at www.dhs.gov/real-id-public-fags for more information.

As a reminder, upgrading your driver's license or ID card to a REAL ID is optional, but mandatory if you plan to use your ID for domestic flights. If you do not have a REAL ID-compliant driver's license you will require a valid passport for a domestic flight. A driver's license without the gold star is not a valid form of ID to travel by air on a domestic flight.
